**Subject : Results Extraordinary General Assembly + next steps**

Dear Membres Titulaires,

Thank you for your strong engagement and active participation in the General Assembly. Your continued commitment reflects the cohesion and strength of our European actuarial community.

We also extend our appreciation to the IFoA Member Association and its representative, Kartina Tahir Thomson, for the clarity of the message delivered and for reaffirming its strong attachment to our Association.

The General Assembly approved, with an 82% majority (above the 75% threshold), the Board's mandate to continue discussions with the IFoA within the existing statutory framework.

The Board has taken note of the IFoA's letter of 18 May and its willingness to engage constructively, including its intention to present a proposal at the Presidents' Meeting on 17 June. This topic will therefore be included on the agenda to facilitate an open and forward-looking dialogue between Member Associations.

The Board will remain fully supportive of all Member Associations. However, acting strictly within the mandate conferred by the General Assembly, its role is to facilitate and support exchanges, and not to act as a negotiating party.

The Board has also decided not to make use of the cooling-off period in respect of Resolution 3 and has agreed to propose Malcolm Kemp as AAE Chair to the General Assembly 2026 in Malaga.

We look forward to seeing you in Paris for the Presidents' Meeting and the European Congress of Actuaries. In the meantime, your AAE Board Liaison and I remain at your disposal for any further information.
