## TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE TASK FORCE ON EDUCATION ON CYBERSECURITY EDUCATION COMMITTEE

In a tense geopolitical environment, cybersecurity issues are becoming increasingly important for European companies. Data security, from acquisition to processing and storage, is particularly relevant to actuaries, especially in the context of implementing artificial intelligence methods. The Education Committee wishes to reflect on the skills and best practices useful to actuaries in their professional activities. This reflection aims to:

- Identify how actuaries can become more visible, based on their roles, skills and scope, in improving the level of cybersecurity
- Provide a knowledge base and resources so that actuaries can easily update themselves on the evolution of best practices in a changing context.
- Promote, to other professions, the fact that actuaries are professionals to whom sensitive data can be entrusted with confidence.
- Identify collaborations with European agencies (notably ENISA)
- Cross-committee collaboration is needed to work on this topic.

The Task Force works basically online and meets whenever is needed.

The Task Force reports to the Education Committee.

It will present its draft conclusions and, if possible, the proposal of paper so that it can be discussed in the Education Committee meeting which will be held in Málaga in October 2026.

The Task Force will be disbanded once the paper is approved by the Board.

By September 26, members of the Task Force are Olivier Lopez and Lourdes Afonso. Information will be sent to other AAE bodies like the Risk Management Committee and the Insurance Committee to call for volunteers.
